Annual Report 2015-'16

By the Grace of God Almighty we have reached the fag end of another academic year. God's unending mercy to us was evident in every single step we put forward this year, especially in the grand finale of the Golden Jubilee celebrations on 17 September 2015 under the leadership of the Manager, Governing Council; and the convenorship of Prof. E. Daniel and Dr. Rajan David. The valedictory function inaugurated by the Honourable Governor of Kerala, Justice P. Sathasivam in the presence of the Mar Thoma Metropolitan, Suffragan Metropolitan, M.P., M.L.A., and many other dignitaries will certainly be recorded in gilded letters in the annals of our College. No words can express the love and cooperation of the teaching and administrative staff, members of the governing council, students, parents and well wishers that has gone into the successful culmination of the Jubilee programmes as well as all the other projects we have undertaken during this year. However, the month of December has left a scar deep in our minds due to the sad demise of our beloved Manager, Dr. Zachariahs Mar Theophilus Suffragan Metropolitan, on 27 December 2016. Christian College family expressed its condolence at the terrible loss of the visionary who inspired us and led us to a safe anchorage in a meeting convened on 4 January 2016. Our loss is indecipherable, but we have to console ourselves with the belief that our Thirumeni has faithfully discharged all earthly duties entrusted by God with utmost diligence and sincerity and hence, is chosen for God's special love and care. With an indescribable sense of gratitude to our beloved Thirumeni this report is being presented before the college community.

Programmes Offered

Our College offers nine Under Graduate courses and five Post Graduate courses. Every department offers short term add on certificate courses for the benefit of students. This year we have succeeded in signing an MoU. The Dept. of Economics has signed an MoU with the National Stock Exchange under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana, and organised a 5 day "Financial Market Skill Development Training Programme" from 27 February to 2 March 2016, which equips the student participants with job opportunities. We have entered the sphere of community development programme in collaboration with JCI Adoor and it was officially inaugurated on 11 March 2016. Similarly the Dept. of English has entered into a contract with the Government of Kerala to conduct residential ASAP training during this summer vacation which will be of 21 days duration. The post graduate departments of Physics, Chemistry and Zoology were jointly selected for the DST-FIST scheme of Govt. of India and a grant of 1 Crore has been sanctioned. Dr. Jisha John and Dr. Rajesh R. of the Department of Economics are principal investigators in a joint research venture with Gulati institute. Prof. Basil Thomas, Department of English has carried out a research project jointly with Indian Institute of Management, Ahmmedabad.

Staff

At present we have 46 permanent teaching staff is and 29 Administrative Staff. The lack of permanent staff is compensated amply with the love and support of 14 guest faculty and 2 sweepers appointed by the Management. Three members of the regular faculty have gone on FDP and their work is effectively being discharged by Substitute lecturers appointed by the UGC. Four of our teachers--Dr. Sunila Abraham, Dr. Vinoy Thomas, Dr. Jayakrishnan R & Dr. Rani

Abraham are accepted as research Guides by the Uty. of Kerala. We have to our credit eleven research papers published in peer reviewed national/ international journals by our teaching faculty and librarian.

Dr. Johnson Baby of the Dept. of Zoology and Dr. Biju Thomas of the Dept. of Political Science are members of the Board of Studies for PG and UG respectively. Two of our teachers -- Prof. A. Abraham and Sri. Rajesh R. have been awarded with doctoral degrees during the current academic year. We are very fortunate that most of our teachers are in great demand as resource persons to many of the seminars organised by institutions in and around Kerala. Dr. A. Abraham, Prof. Basil Thomas, Dr.Tiju Jospeh Mathew & Prof. Fancy D. R. have served as members of the Mal-practice prevention squad of the University of Kerala.

Smt. Pheba Ann Zachariah joined the Dept. of Economics as Assistant Professor during the beginning of this academic year. Professor K.M. Abraham, Head of the department of History is retiring by the end of May 2016. Christian College family is deeply indebted to Prof. K. M. Abraham for his valuable service in all fields. We will certainly cherish the heroic and effective leadership he has given us during our re accreditation which had earned for us A grade. We wish him a blissful and fruitful retired life.

Dr. R. Jayakrishnan, Assistant Professor in the Department of Physics is honoured with the Young Scientist Award by the Kerala State Council for Science, Technology & Environment in a meeting held in NIIT Calicut. The Chief Minister of Kerala gave away the Award. Dr. Tiju Joseph Mathew, Department of Physics secured the ERASMUS MUNDUS Fellowship and is presently working as Post Doctoral Fellow in Cyprus. He has also secured C. V. Raman Fellowship and will proceed to the USA after completion of the tenure of present Fellowship. The Logo designed by Dr. Abhilash R. and Chinnu Sasisdharan (First M.Sc.
