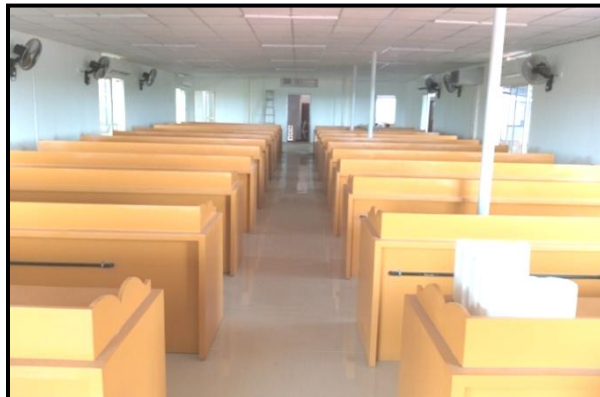

- On Saturday, 23 **March 2019** Members of the Teaching Staff went on a one day picnic to Kuttikanam and Panchalimedu.

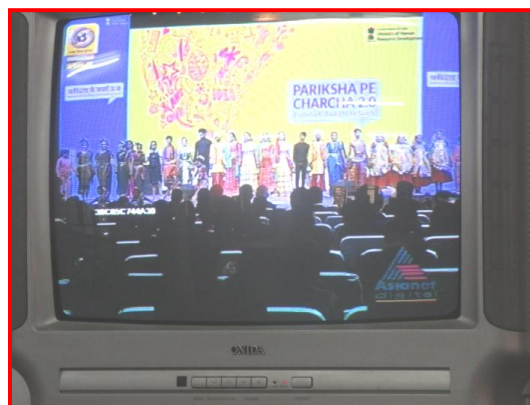


### Library

- The college has a fully automated library that uses the software “Libsoft”, with a collection of 30250 volumes including text books and bound periodicals.
- The library subscribes to 50 periodicals and 20 journals.
- The library offers Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) and also the bar code facility for easy detection and circulation of books.



- Facility is being provided to staff and students to watch important telecasts like Budget and speeches.



- The library avails Inflibnet facility of UGC that gives access to more than 3000 e-journals and nearly 90000 books.
- CCTV (with 8 cameras) facility is installed in the library with UGC support to watch and make sure that the facilities provided are properly being used by the stake holders.

### **Flood Relief Measures**

From **August 17 to 29 August 2018**, with the permission of the Manager, our college and its premises were opened to people rescued from flooded areas. We served as the collection cum distribution centre for distribution of food and provision items to around 2700 people in our camp as well as neighboring rescue centres. The Chief Minister, many of the State Ministers, Opposition Leader, National leaders like Sri. Rahul Gandhi, B.J.P. State President, MPs, MLAs, and Cine actors visited the camp supervised by us.



Our Staff, Management, Alumni as well as students offered their services continuously round the clock. Some of our teachers were engaged in the rescue operations along with the military force. Provisions, Consumable food items, baby food, stationary, dress items, mats and chapels were donated by our friends,



well-wishers and alumni for the inmates in our camp. We have spent an amount of Rs. 1, 12,179/- for constructing green toilets, as rent for cooking utensils, remuneration for cooks, watchman, for cleaning & disinfecting the whole college and premises and for urgent repair works. We were able to donate 1.5 tonnes of Bleaching Powder to Chengannur Municipality. 14 members of our Non- teaching staff and 10 Teaching Staff members were affected by flood. We also supplied food, stationary kits and dresses to the Non-Teaching staff who have incurred terrible loss. The Teaching Staff Association raised Rs.1,50,000/- and distributed to the Non-Teaching members who were affected by flood. Teaching Staff donated Rs. 2,39,140/- and Non- Teaching Staff donated Rs. 26,630/- to Chief Minister's Distress Relief Fund from their salary. Our students have donated Rs. 30,255/- which was handed over to P.W.D. Minister at a meeting convened by University of Kerala in M.S.M. College, Kayamkulam. Our students cooperated immensely with the Flood Relief Project of Govt. of Kerala by digitally entering the list of recipients of flood relief amount of Thiruvananthapuram Panchayat.

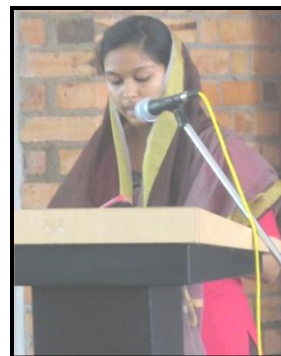
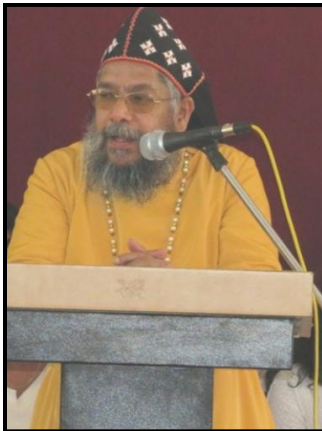




- The Inter-Department Carol Competition was conducted in the Meditation Centre on **6 December 2018**

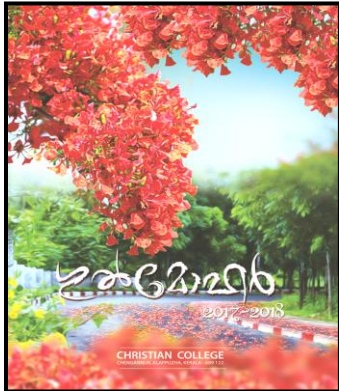

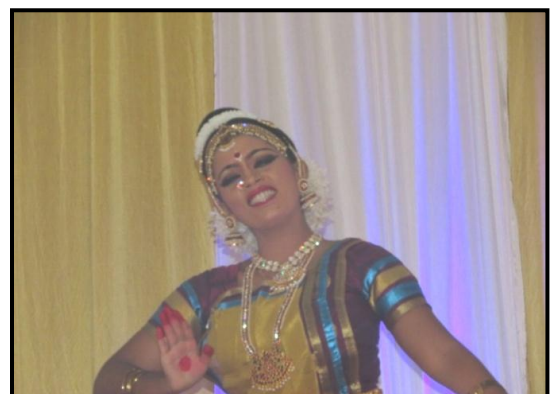
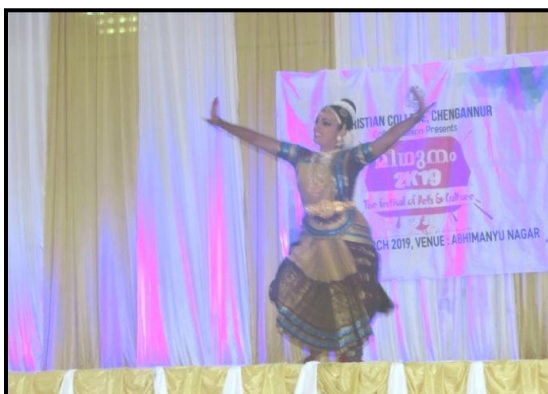

## Department of English

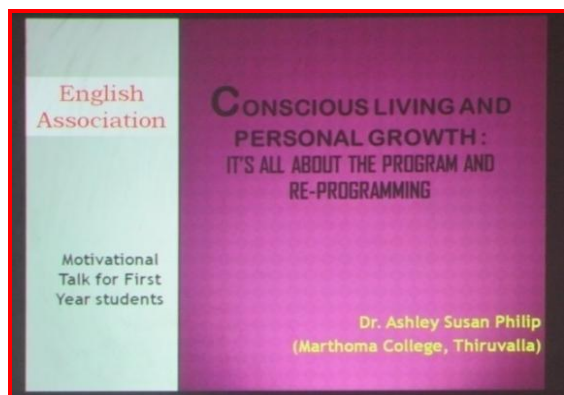

### **Birds Club International (Dr. Abhilash R.)**

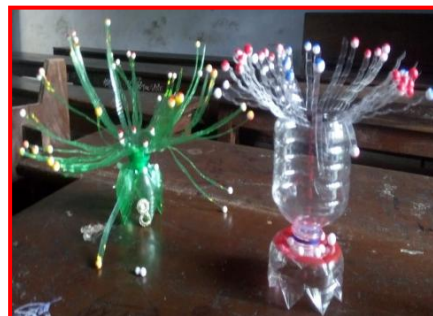

- The Centre for Social Action (CSA) organized a training session by the Paraplegic association for making paper bags & paper pens on **7 February 2019**.

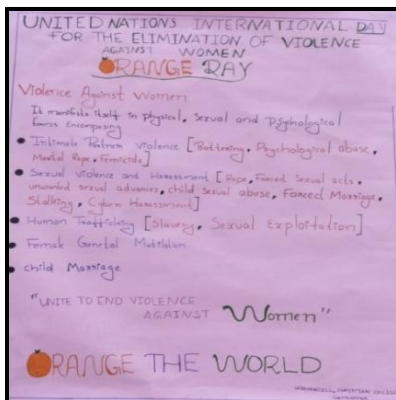


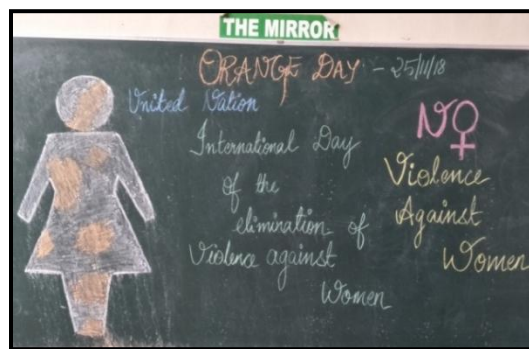
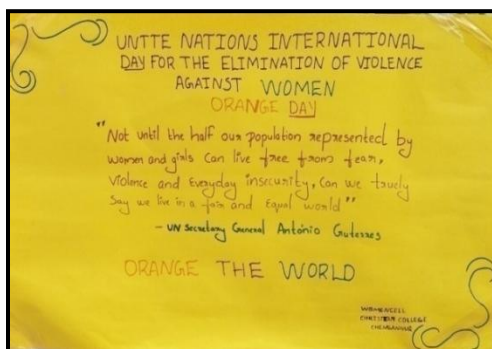
