



Opinion with respect to parameters of curriculum suitability and co-curricular activities continued to show an upward trend among parents in the year 2017-18 (100% each). Opinion of assessment of students' achievement through various academic programmes rose to 96% (excellent to good) and Teachers' approach to students was rated as good to excellent by all of the parents. The College was rated from good to excellent in the avauilability of references by all the parents. The parents had only good words about the College atmosphere to make the higher education process more effective. Efforts designed to simplify the burden of curriculam were also commended by parents. Quality of teaching was rated from good to excellent by all of them. Regarding the helpfulness of College activities, in ensuring employment opportunities, 64% of parents gave only an average grade. 




















PARENTS' FEEDBACK ON SYLLABUS – 2017- 18 CHRISTIAN COLLEGE CHENGANNUR

The participation of students in extracurricular activities in the current year has been graded positively by a whopping majority of 97% parents. Most of them (93%) found the curriculam followed suitable to ease the learning process. 98% of parents rated the aviality of references in the campus from good to excellent. A high percentage of parents (98%0 voted positively for the assessment of student's achievements through various academic programmes. They (96%) have a high opinion regarding teacher's approach towards students. 87% of them considered the College atmosphere conducive to make the higher education process more effective. 85% found the various programmes and activities that simplify the burden of curriculam to be effective. Three quarter of the parents regarded the quality of teaching from good to excellent. Only half of the parents believe that the College activities provide employment opportunities for their wards. 57% opined that the scholarships and other aids provided to the students are helpful.
