





**ORDER**

The Budget Speech 2018-'19 envisaged the enhancement of remuneration payable to the scribes appointed for the eligible, differently abled candidates appearing for the University Examinations from Rs.50/- to Rs.250/- per paper. The Senate approved the same vide read (1) above. The Finance endorsed the payment accordingly, vide read (2) above. It was also proposed to request the Principal/chief superintendent to submit separate bills towards the claims, in order to avoid the delay in processing the claims along with the other expenditures related to conduct of examinations.

Sanction has, therefore, been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor for the enhancement of remuneration payable to scribes for the service rendered to the eligible, differently abled candidates appearing for the theory papers of the University Examinations from Rs.50/- to Rs.250/- per paper. The amount shall be claimed by the concerned Principal/chief superintendent in separate bills to avoid unnecessary delay.

The hike in remuneration comes to effect from the date of issuance of this U.O.
